Volunteer opportunities include:

> Meal Provider (*Greatest Need)

Volunteers donate and deliver a hot dinner, and/or a continental breakfast, and/or a sack to-go lunch for 20 people.

> Evening Shelter Host (7:00pm-10:00pm)

Volunteers help staff get set-up for the evening, greet shelter guests as they arrive, help them set up their sleeping area, host/serve dinner, and interact with clients until lights out.

> Overnight Attendant (10:00pm-5:00am)

Volunteers support staff in ensuring a safe experience for the shelter guests.

> Breakfast Host (5:00am-7:00am)

Volunteers serve a light breakfast, help shelter guests exit, and assist with light clean-up/
