#### WHAT IS HOUSING FORWARD?

Housing Forward is a nonprofit working to end homelessness. With the help of local faith communities, we operated a rotating PADS shelter system for more than 25 years. In 2020, the pandemic brought unprecedented challenges to the congregate shelter system, and we adapted quickly, reimagining our service model and creating new programs. Today Housing Forward prevents homelessness whenever possible, responds to housing crises when they do occur, and provides a pathway to stability through housing and supportive services. Over the past three decades we have helped more than 25,000 people in 26 different west suburban communities.

#### WHAT DO HOUSING FORWARD VOLUNTEERS DO?

Our greatest need is meal providers. Last year, thanks to your generosity, we provided nearly 100,000 meals to guests staying in our Emergency Shelter and Interim Housing programs. In 2024, homelessness rose by 18% nationwide, reaching the highest level ever recorded by HUD. At the same time, federal funding and protections for people experiencing homelessness are increasingly at risk. In response to this growing crisis, Housing Forward is preparing to open a larger, 40-bed Emergency Overnight Shelter this summer at 112 S. Humphrey Avenue in Oak Park.
